1. AFFILIATED MEMBERS:

• We no longer have any affiliated clubs/members due to our move to Aikido Alliance UK.

2. BRITISH AIKIDO BOARD (BAB) / AIKIDO ALLIANCE UK:

 After careful consideration we decided on 4th October to resign our membership of the BAB and join Aikido Alliance UK. More information later in the meeting.

3. DOJO CHANGES:

- Monday class at Fareham Leisure Centre was reduced to one court and limited to members 3rd Kyu and above.
- We have reduced the booking at ALNS on Sundays from 1.00pm to 12.30pm due to poor attendance by adult 18+ members on Sundays, as a result the intermediate class was reduced by 15 minutes (finishing at 11.45pm instead of 12.00pm)
- We are currently trialling a low impact martial arts/aikido class at Fareham Leisure Centre on Wednesday evening.

4. MEMBERSHIP:

- <u>24</u> new memberships issued since the 1st September 2023, compared to <u>28</u> last year, and <u>27</u> the previous year, who may not still be training, or may have only attended one session, but indicates the success or lack of success of advertising!
